COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$470 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended August 23.

The principal net decreases were \$63 million in loans to the mining industry, which includes producers of petroleum and natural gas, \$60 million to manufacturers of machinery, and \$52 million to retail trade.

The larger offsetting net increases were \$23 million in loans in Bankers' acceptances, and \$21 million to "all other" types of business concerns.
