COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased in ten districts and a net of \$192 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended October 4.

The principal net increases were \$94 million in loans to "other" public utilities, \$38 million to transportation, \$37 million to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products, \$27 million to communications, and \$42 million to unclassified borrowers.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$46 million in loans to the mining industry, which includes producers of petroleum and natural gas.
