COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$46 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended October 18.

The principal net decreases were \$70 million in loans to "other" public utilities, \$52 million to manufacturers of machinery, \$49 million to manufacturers of "other" durable goods.

The larger offsetting net increases were \$93 million in loans to retail trade, and \$64 million to commodity dealers.
