COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$219 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended October 25.

The principal net decreases were \$99 million in loans to "other" public utilities, \$96 million to retail trade, and \$83 million to manufacturers of textiles, apparel, and leather products.

The largest offsetting net increase was \$71 million in loans to manufacturers of transportation equipment.
