COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$3 million in weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended December 13.

The principal net decreases were \$51 million in loans to manufacturers of transportation equipment, \$39 million to retail trade, \$37 million to "other" public utilities, and \$36 million to "all other" types of business concerns.

The larger offsetting net increases were \$30 million in loans to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products, \$24 million to services, \$23 million to "other" wholesale trade, and \$67 million to unclassified borrowers.
