COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased in all districts and a net of \$1,355 million in weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended December 20.

The principal net increases were \$182 million in loans to "other" public utilities, \$174 million to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products, \$149 million to transportation, \$90 million to "all other" types of business concerns, and \$72 million to manufacturers of machinery.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$30 million in loans to the construction industry.
