## COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased in ten districts and a net of \$123 million in weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended March 13.

The principal net increases were \$44 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, \$39 million to manufacturers of textiles, apparel, and leather, \$38 million to transportation, and \$36 million to the mining industry, which includes producers of petroleum and natural gas.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$111 million in loans to "other" public utilities.
