COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased in eight districts and a net of \$161 million in weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended April 10.

The principal net increases were \$58 million in loans to retail trade, \$52 million to manufacturers of textiles, apparel, and leather products, \$46 million to manufacturers of chemicals and rubber products, and \$57 million to "all types of business concerns."

The larger offsetting net decrease was \$59 million in loans to communication.
