COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased in eleven districts and a net of \$207 million in weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended May 15.

The principal net increases were \$46 million in loans to retail trade and \$42 million in loans to construction and \$97 million to unclassified borrowers.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$38 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery.
