COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$57 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended July 10.

The principal net decreases were \$85 million in loans to manufacturers of chemicals and rubber products, \$42 million each to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products, and to communications, and \$52 million to "all other" types of business concerns.

The largest offsetting net increase was \$59 million in loans in bankers' acceptances.
