COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$132 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended August 21.

The principal net decreases were \$73 million in loans to manufacturers of transportation equipment, and \$69 million to retail trade.

The larger offsetting net increases were \$83 million in loans to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products, and \$80 million to unclassified borrowers.
