COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased in nine districts and a net of \$332 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended September 11.

The principal net increases were \$82 million in loans to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products, \$53 million to manufacturers of machinery, and \$148 million to unclassified borrowers.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$52 million in loans in bankers' acceptances.
