COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased in all districts and a net of \$424 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended October 16.

The principal net increases were \$188 million in loans to retail trade, \$71 million to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products, \$66 million to "all other" types of business concerns, and \$64 million to "other" wholesale trade.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$57 million in loans in bankers' acceptances.
