COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased in eleven districts and a net of \$1,283 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended December 18.

The principal net increases were \$158 million in loans to "other" public utilities, \$157 million to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products, \$151 million to manufacturers of machinery, \$144 million to retail trade, and \$228 million to "all other" loans.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$129 million in loans to unclassified borrowers.
