COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$93 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended April 23.

The principal net decreases were \$72 million in loans to transportation, \$43 million to manufacturers of machinery, \$42 million to commodity dealers, \$41 million in bankers' acceptances, and \$240 million to unclassified borrowers.

The larger offsetting net increases were \$124 million in loans to retail trade, and \$70 million to "all other" types of business concerns.
