COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$153 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended May 14.

The principal net increases were \$96 million in loans to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products, \$59 million to "other" durable goods, and \$77 million to unclassified borrowers.

The larger offsetting net decreases were \$72 million in loans to commodity dealers, and \$64 million to "other" public utilities.
