COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased in all districts and a net of \$955 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended June 18.

The principal net increases were \$201 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, \$115 million to retail trade, \$89 million to manufacturers of transportation equipment, and \$242 million to unclassified borrowers.

The larger offsetting net decreases were \$52 million in loans to manufacturers of primary metals, and \$49 million to "all other" types of business concerns.
