COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased in eight districts and a net of \$53 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended June 25.

The principal net decreases were \$36 million in loans to retail trade, \$31 million to manufacturers of machinery, \$29 million to manufacturers of transportation equipment, and \$226 million to unclassified borrowers.

The largest offsetting net increase was \$85 million in loans to "all other" types of business concerns.
