### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$153 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended July 16.

The principal net decrease in loans to manufacturers was a decline of \$44 million to petroleum refiners. Loans to transportation companies also were down \$44 million while "all other loans" were off by \$62 million.

The largest offsetting net increases were rises of \$35 million in loans to the wholesale trade industry, \$33 million to the transportation industry and \$31 million to the construction industry.
