COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$340 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended August 13.

The principal net decreases were \$80 million in loans to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products, \$60 million to petroleum refiners, and \$201 million to unclassified borrowers.

The larger offsetting net increases were \$64 million in loans to "all other" types of business concerns, and \$55 million to the construction industry.
