COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$177 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended August 20.

The principal net decreases were \$66 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, and \$46 million to commodity dealers.

The largest offsetting net increase was \$58 million in loans to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products.
