COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$54 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended October 8.

The principal net decreases were \$96 million in loans to petroleum refiners, \$48 million to the mining industry, which includes producers of petroleum and natural gas, and \$41 million to unclassified borrowers.

The largest offsetting net increase was \$96 million in loans to retail trade.
