COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$371 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended October 22.

The principal net decreases were \$80 million in loans to manufacturers of textiles, apparel, and leather products, \$55 million to manufacturers of "other" fabricated metal products, \$54 million to manufacturers of "other" durable goods, and \$62 million to unclassified borrowers.

The larger offsetting net increases were \$29 million in loans to retail trade, and \$22 million to manufacturers of transportation equipment.
