COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$856 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended April 15.

The principal net increases were \$136 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, \$103 million in bankers' acceptances, \$267 million to retail trade, and \$349 million to unclassified borrowers.

The larger offsetting net decreases were \$72 million in loans to "other" public utilities, and \$60 million to all "other" types of business concerns.
