COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$419 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended May 13.

The principal net decreases were \$106 million in loans to retail trade, and \$131 million to unclassified borrowers.

The larger offsetting net increase was \$120 million in loans to all "other" types of business concerns.
