### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$140 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended June 3.

The principal net increases were \$67 million in loans to "other" public utilities, \$73 million to services, and \$157 million to unclassified borrowers.

The larger offsetting net decreases were \$83 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, \$54 million to manufacturers of transportation equipment, and \$51 million to all "other" types of business concerns.

#### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL TERM LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Total business term loans were \$31,393 million as of May. This was an increase of \$423 million over the comparable data a year ago and a decrease of \$88 million from the last Wednesday in March.

The principal net changes in term loans during May were decreases of \$137 million in loans to manufacturers of chemical and rubber products, and \$70 million to the mining industry.

The total of all business term loans on May 27 represented approximately 47 per cent of total of business loans outstanding at large commercial banks reporting in the series.
