COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$13 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended August 12.

The principal net decreases were \$69 million in loans to retail trade, and \$41 million to unclassified borrowers.

The largest offsetting net increase was \$47 million in loans in bankers' acceptances.
