COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$974 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended September 16.

The principal net increases were \$87 million in loans to manufacturers of transportation equipment, \$80 million to manufacturers of "other" fabricated metal products, \$93 million to manufacturers of "other" nondurable goods, and \$179 million to unclassified borrowers.
