### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$24 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended September 23.

The principal net increases were \$94 million in loans to services, \$60 million in bankers' acceptances, and \$60 million to foreign commercial and industrial loans.

The larger offsetting net decreases were \$98 million in loans to manufacturers of "other" fabricated metal products, and \$98 million to "other" public utilities.
