COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$468 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended October 28.

The principal net decreases were $$185\ \text{million}$ in loans to manufacturers of machinery, and $$173\ \text{million}$ to all "other" types of business concerns.

The largest offsetting net increase was \$153 million in loans to retail trade.
