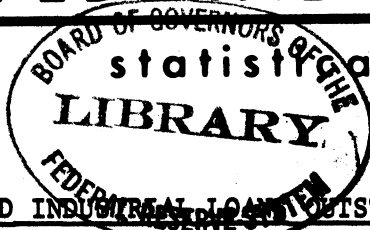

COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$243 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended April 22.

The principal net increases were \$88 million in loans to "All other loans", and \$112 to unclassified borrowers.

The larger offsetting net decreases were \$63 million in loans to transportation equipment, and \$58 million to commodity dealers.
