COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$138 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended May 19.

The principal net increases were \$113 million in loans to retail trade, and \$238 million to unclassified borrowers.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$145 million in loans in bankers' acceptances.
