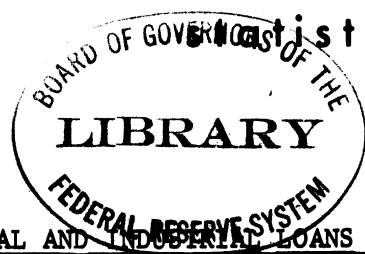

COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$285 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended July 21.

The principal net decreases were \$107 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, and \$58 million to communications.
