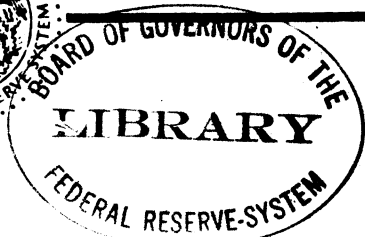

COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$115 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended August 25.

The principal net increases were \$88 million in foreign commercial and industrial loans, \$77 million to all "other loans", and \$57 million to "other wholesale trade".

The larger offsetting net decreases were \$80 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, \$36 million in loans to retail trade and \$34 million in loans to manufacturers of "other fabricated metal products".
