COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$871 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended September 15.

The principal net increases were \$147 million to manufacturers of transportation equipment, \$65 million to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products, and \$53 million to "other" nondurable goods.

The larger offsetting net decreases were \$36 million to all "other" loans, and \$6 million to bankers' acceptances loans.
