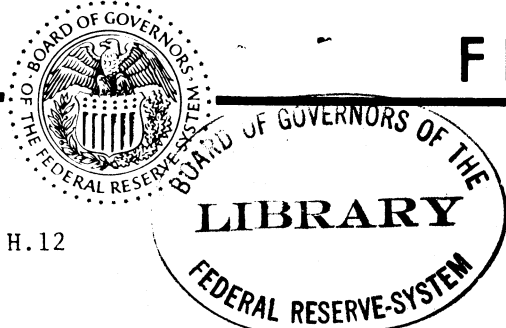

### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$25 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended September 22.

The principal net decreases were \$92 million in loans to manufacturers of textiles, apparel, and leather products, and \$86 million to foreign commercial and industrial loans.

The larger offsetting net increases were \$74 million in loans to retail trade, \$70 million to transportation, and \$66 million to unclassified borrowers.
