COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$222 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended October 20,

The principal net decreases were \$67 million in loans to manufacturers of transportation equipment, \$66 million to textiles, apparel, and leather products.

The largest offsetting net increase was \$71 million in loans to commodity dealers.
