COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$157 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended November 11.

The principal net decreases were \$57 million in loans to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products, and \$38 million to "other" fabricated metal products.

The largest offsetting net increase was \$45 million in loans to services.
