COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$88 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended November 17.

The principal net decreases were \$74 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, and \$68 million to "other" public utilities.

The largest offsetting net increases were \$72 million in loans to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products, and \$106 million in bankers' acceptances.
