### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$216 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended November 24.

The principal net decreases were \$124 million in loans to manufacturers of primary metals, and \$112 million to manufacturers of machinery.

The largest offsetting net increases were \$70 million in loans to manufacturers of food, liquor, and tobacco products, and \$79 million to retail trade.
