COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$151 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended December 22.

The principal net decreases were \$124 million in loans to retail trade, \$156 million to communications, and \$96 million to manufacturers of machinery.

The larger offsetting net increases were \$106 million in loans to "other" public utilities, and \$91 million to unclassified borrowers.
