

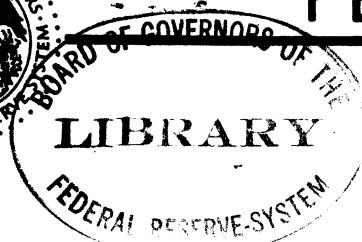

COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans decreased a net of \$20 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended December 29.

The principal net decreases were \$150 million in loans to retail trade, and \$89 million to chemical and rubber products.

the larger offsetting net decreases were \$131 million in loans in bankers' acceptances, and \$148 million to unclassified borrowers.
