COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$369 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended February 16.

The principal net increases were \$83 million in loans to manufacturers of transportation equipment, \$101 million to retail trade, and \$76 million to unclassified borrowers.
