### COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$162 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended March 1.

The principal net increases were \$56 million in loans to all "other" types of business concerns, and \$76 million to unclassified borrowers.

COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL TERM LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Total business loans were \$31,610 million as of February. This was a decrease of \$871 million over the comparable data a year ago and an increase of \$148 million from the last Wednesday in January.

The principal net changes were \$87 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery, \$86 million in construction loans, \$57 million in loans for services, and \$57 million in all "other" types of business concerns.

The total of all business term loans on February 23 represented approximately 45 percent of business loans outstanding at large commercial banks reporting in the series.
