COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$96 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended March 8.

The principal net increases were \$64 million in loans to manufacturers of textiles, apparel, and leather and \$39 million in loans to manufacturers of other durable goods.
