COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$797 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended March 15.

The principal net increases were \$150 million in loans to manufacturers of textiles, apparel, and leather, \$143 million in loans to manufacturers of machinery and \$116 million in all "other" loans.
