H.12 COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$34 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended March 22.

The principal net increases were \$43 million in loans to other wholesale trade, \$37 million in loans to communication industry, and \$116 million in unclassified loans.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$191 million in loans for bankers' acceptances.
