COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$356 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended March 29.

The principal net increases were \$158 million in loans to retail trade, \$59 million in loans to services and \$121 million in total unclassified loans.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$60 million in loans for other public utilities.
