



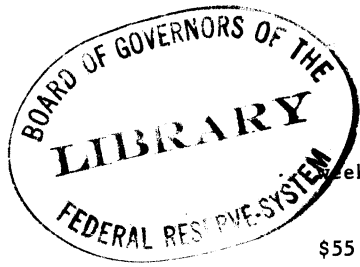

COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY



Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$151 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended April 12.

The principal net increases were \$56 million in loans to machinery, \$55 million in loans to chemicals and rubber, and \$45 million in loans to construction.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$88 million in bankers' acceptances.
