COMMERCIAL AND INDUSTRIAL LOANS OUTSTANDING BY INDUSTRY

Commercial and industrial loans increased a net of \$53 million at weekly reporting large commercial banks during the week ended April 26.

The principal net increases were \$35 million in loans to retail trade, \$91 million in loans to other public utilities and \$49 million to unclassified borrowers.

The largest offsetting net decrease was \$68 million in loans to manufacturers of transportation equipment.
